On friday we did a freshshow in Bremen (86.23)

On saturday we drove to Colone and did on sunday streetshows at the stairway between the Dom and the River (373.78)

On monday we drove to Antwerp and did a freshshow (89.13)

On tuesday as well.(107.26)

On wensday we drove to Lauwe in Belgium and worked at a festival. (1500.-)

On thursday we drove the 850 km to Augsburg to the LA STRADA Festival.

Bobarino and Fraulein Döpp were there in 2009 and changed the Festival. Before it was a competition now it is not. You get 440.- to be there and you play for the hat. And the Augsburg People are wonderful as an audience and for filling the hat.



On friday it was raining, no shows. 14 groups had to rest and hang out.

On Saturday it was less rain, a mixed Show (957.82) with all performers and some solo shows (whatever they made).

On sunday two Variety shows on two stages (4127,- divided between 18 Artists).

We will be back next year!

And again back to our farm. The weather is cold now here in the north. We prepare us and our cars for the next month. We will be at the gay-games in Colone ... maybe see you there?

It was a busy month with a lot of driving (510.-€ for gas), being in different places with different people in different weather.
Enjoying the sun and pass through the rain.
Just a few last things to say.

James has been working in Vermont for the last month and that is why he has not been seen so much in this and junes newsletter. He is miles from a computer and 2-3 times a month is able to hitchhike into town to do some shopping and what not. He is working in a youth camp as the camp medic. We have had a few correspondences and he informs us that he is gaining good experience in the field of emergency medical care as well as the up keep of a medical supply and dispensation tent.
James is in the process of putting together a medical kit that we will bring onto the bus, he has also been studying information concerning some of the scary things we may encounter in mexico and central amerika and is hoping to be able to counter any medical issues that may arise. If anyone has some input in regard to being prepared we appreciate it very mucho.

In October we drive 3200 km from Portland to Puebla. The Bus eats 40 liter in 100km, one liter is 0.60\$
The Mini Winny eats 30 liter in 100 km,
And our little voyeger van will use 12 liter for 100 km.... so calculate!!

From Puebla to Panama the tires rol on for another 2500 km.... more to calculate??
